

# Smart Snacks in Schools

- Identify all areas of the school where food is sold (cafeteria, school stores, teacher's classroom, vending machines, car lines, etc.).
- Decide if the items being sold meet Smart Snacks Standards if they do highlight the group's efforts in the daily announcements, school marquee, or school newsletter.
- If the items are not Smart Snacks compliant, notify the administration that the items do not meet standards and must be removed immediately.
- Assist the group with identifying Smart Snacks items using the Alliance for a Healthier Generation's Smart Snacks calculator [Smart Snacks Product Calculator \(healthiergeneration.org\)](https://www.healthiergeneration.org/smart-snacks-product-calculator)
- Distribute the Smart Snacks guidelines using this link [A Guide to Smart Snacks in School \(azureedge.us\)](https://www.azureedge.us)
- Every three months randomly select items being sold and determine if they meet Smart Snack standards.
- Print copies of "A Guide to Smart Snacks in School" and post them in the classroom, cafeteria, and hallways.
